



**REGULATIONS
OF THE WORLD BILLIARD SPORT CHAMPIONSHIP
“FREE PYRAMID”**

men, women

23-29 August 2021, Khanty-Mansiysk, Russia

1. Objectives and Tasks

- developing and strengthening international sporting relations in the field of billiards sports;
- promoting the “Free Pyramid” as a pyramid billiard game and making it more popular in different countries of the world;
- identifying the world best players based on the results of the World “Free Pyramid” Championship (hereinafter - the Championship)

2. Event Schedule and Venue

The Championship is held out from 23 to 29 of August, 2021, in Khanty-Mansiysk (Russia) in “the “Tennis sport developing centre” (Studencheskaya ulitsa, 21).

3. Championship's management and arrangement

1. General management of the Championship is held out by the International Pyramid Confederation under the auspices of the World Confederation of Billiards Sports with the assistance of the Sports Ministry of Russian Federation, Billiard sport federation of Russia, and Physical culture and sport department of Hunty-Mansiyskiy autonomic region – Yugra.

2. Direct management and arrangement of the Championship is held out by the Autonomic institution «YugraMegaSport», «Billiard sport federation of Hunty-Mansiyskiy autonomic region – Yugra» and the Chief referee board of the Championship, approved by the International Pyramid Confederation.

3. Chief referee of the event – Yuri Chervanov, referee of the international degree (Belarus).

4. Participation Conditions

4.1. The Championship brings together the world's best sportsmen playing Free pyramid.

4.2. Sportsmen are allowed to participate in the Championship if their names are included in the personal bid submitted by a national billiard sport federation.

The Championship's participation quotas are as follows:

4.2.1. 5 men and 4 women – from Russia, Belarus, Ukraine, Kazakhstan, Kirgizstan;

4.2.2. 3 men and 1 woman – from Azerbaijan, Moldova, Mongolia, Finland.

4.2.3. 1 man and 1 woman – from Armenia, Georgia, Lithuania, Latvia. Estonia, Tajikistan, Turkmenia, Uzbekistan.

4.2.4. 15 men from distant countries;

4.2.5. 1 man and 1 woman – the winners of the 2019 World Championship on the "Free Pyramid";

4.2.6. Finalists of the 2019 Free Pyramid World Cups (Moscow Mayor cup, Kremlin cup);

4.2.7. 2 men and 2 women – from the country arranging the Championship.

National federations shall send their bids for Championship participation to the International Pyramid Confederation no later than August 16, 2021, by e-mail: mail@fbsrf.ru.

Russian Billiard Sport Federation as a hosting side of the Championship have the right to include its sportsmen instead of the absent participants.

Once the preliminary registration is completed, the possibility of granting additional places to national federations will also be considered.

5. Dress Code

The following dress code is established for the Championship's participants:

- dark shoes, dark trousers, one-colour shirt with long sleeves, one-colour waistcoat, bow-tie (for gentlemen).

- dark shoes, dark trousers, one-colour shirt or blouse with long sleeves, one-colour waistcoat (for ladies).

The participants' attire shall be tidy and neat. The shirt (blouse) shall be tucked in the trousers. Any participant who does not comply with the established dress code shall not be allowed to participate in the competition.

The procedure for putting advertising signs and emblems on the attire of the Championship's participants is regulated by the current international legislation and international rules for holding out billiard sport competitions.

6. Event Conditions and Procedure

The competition is held out in accordance with the current IPC rules for the "Free Pyramid" game. The players' seeding will take into account their national federation affiliation and IPC ranking.

The Championship format implies double elimination system. The individual matches format will be determined by the Chief referee board in accordance with the Organizer/

There will be no matches for the 3rd and the 4th place; both sportsmen who lose semi-final matches will be awarded bronze medals.

All the other issues related to changes and supplements to the Championship's conditions and procedure and not included in the present Regulations shall be addressed by the Organizer together with the Chief referee board.

7. Accommodation of Competition's Participants

The competition's participants are offered to accommodate in Hotel Olimpiyskaya (Khanty-Mansiysk, Ulitsa Engelsa 45). The costs of a daily stay are as follows:

Single room – 3600 rubbles;

Double room – 4600 rubbles (2300 rubbles per person);

Studio – 6000 rubbles;

Lux – 7000 rubbles.

Meals and accommodations are at the expense of the national federations.

8. Refereeing

The Championship's refereeing is performed in accordance with the current IPC Rules.

The Championship's referee staff is approved by the IPC on the proposal of the Championship's Chief Referee.

9. Awarding

Sportsmen having taken the first, the second and the third places be awarded with cups, medals, diplomas and money prizes.

The overall prize fund amounts to 2,100,000 rubbles:
